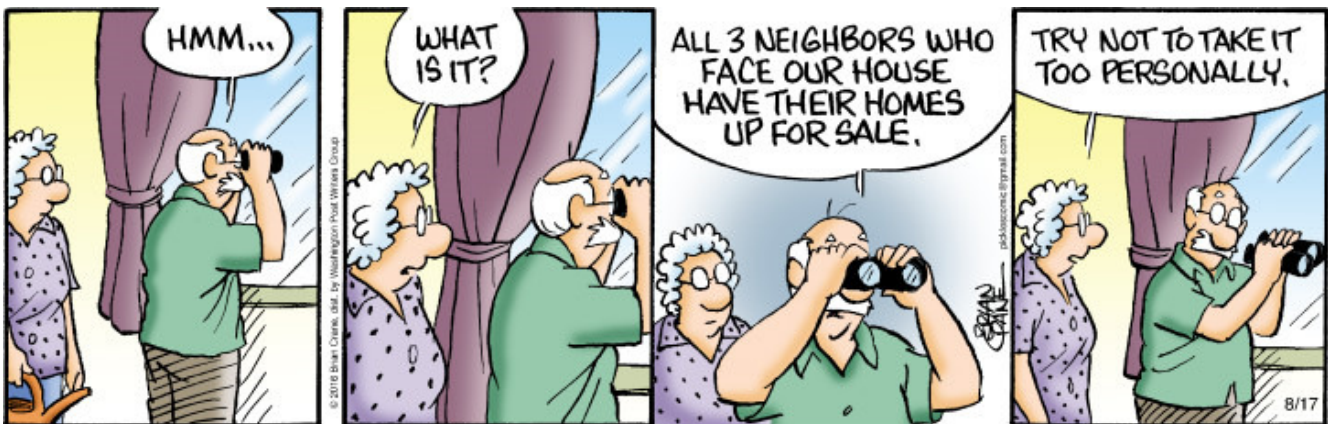
I am always in awe of the wonderful neighbors here in Glengarry. I am truly blessed to live here.

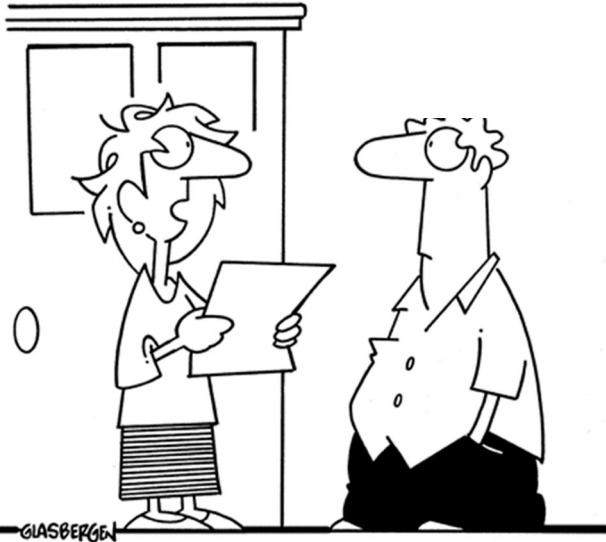
