## SENIOR SAFETY TIPS FOR WINTER

### 1. Avoid slipping on ice

Wear shoes with good traction and non-skid soles, and stay inside until the roads are clear.

### 2. Dress for warmth

Wear warm socks, a heavy coat, a warm hat, gloves and a scarf if heading outdoors. In very cold temperatures, cover all exposed skin and use a scarf to cover your mouth.

### 3. Fight wintertime depression

Arrange a check-in system with family, neighbors and friends, where each person looks in on one or two others daily.

### 4. Keep the car tuned up

Get the car serviced for the winter. Check the oil, tires, battery and wipers. Keep roadside assistance plan up-to-date.

### 5. Prepare for power outages

Have easy access to flashlights and a battery-powered radio in case the power goes out. Stockpile warm blankets. Keep a supply of non-perishable foods that can be eaten cold on hand.

### 6. Eat a varied diet

Spending more time indoors in the winter you should consume foods that are fortified with Vitamin D, such as milk, grains and seafood options like tuna and salmon.

### 7. Prevent carbon monoxide poisoning

Check the batteries on carbon monoxide detector and buying an updated one if you need to.

This is a great neighborhood with wonderful neighbors and I'm very happy to be here!



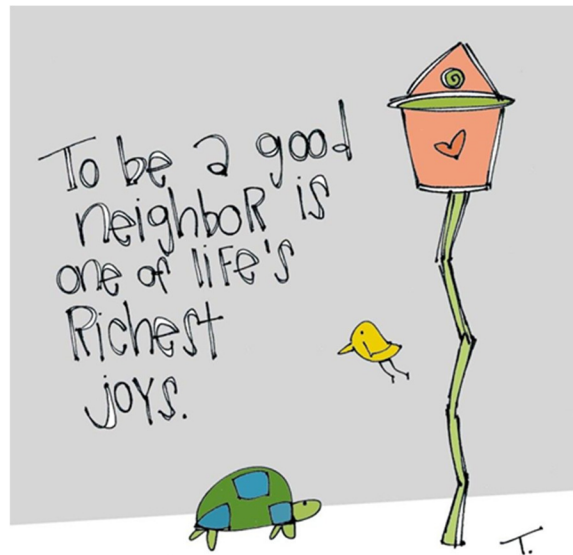
